Girls Living Life On Purpose, Inc. (GLLOP) is the premier all girl faith based organization dedicated solely in empowering African American and minority girls through life purpose coaching, character development, and abstinence education.

Everyone was created for a unique purpose and our organization is dedicated to helping girls discover and live out their unique purpose.

Currently, we offer two unique programs for girls. Each program is designed to create a process of change, a relationship of growth and a path to discovery. This strategic process results in a clearer understanding and vision of the intersection of their passions and God's purpose for their life.

GLLOP is an IRS 501c3 nonprofit organization.

our mission

To inspire girls to discover who they are, to connect with other likeminded girls and to pursue their purpose with passion.

purpose girls academy (pga)

PGA is a unique program that serves as a foundation to empower girls with a deeper sense of identity and purpose. PGA empowers girls academically, spiritually and emotionally. PGA builds self-confidence, creates accountability, and guides girls along their pathway to purpose.

- Each session is facilitated by trained and/or certified professionals who are experts in their field.
- PGA operates for 12 months Jan-Dec. Programs are offered every 2nd and 4th Saturday from 1p to 4p generally (depending on age group).
- PGA accepts applications between Sept-Dec for the following year.

enrollment/membership

Membership is open to all girls ages 12 to 17. Annual membership fee: \$40 per girl/per year. payment plans available

mentor-coaching program

In Dallas County between 1999-2002 there was a 54% increase of female juvenile arrests for violent felony offenses. During the same period, misdemeanor assaults increased 183%. Though this number is on the decline today it is not declining fast enough. There is still much to be done and we need your help....

Through an innovative partnership with the Dallas County Juvenile Department (DCJD), Girls Living Life On Purpose, Inc (GLLOP) has the opportunity to reach out and mentor girls ages 12 to 17 of Dallas County who are being adjudicated through the DCJD. These girls have many challenges, but mostly they just need someone positive in their life. Mentors can help by offering support, a listening ear and heart, reinforcement and accountability. Most are from low-income, single-parent families. Your mentoring relationship will begin while the girl is in the custody of the juvenile department and will continue once they are released.
